Community Resilience:

Preparing for and recovering from emergencies



Incident management:

Coordinating an effective response



Information Management:

Making sure people have information to take action



Countermeasures and Mitigation:

Getting medicines and supplies where they are needed



Surge Management:

Expanding medical services to handle large events



Biosurveillance:

Investigating and identifying health threats
