



### Screening Tools Used to Assess for Suicide Risk in Children




#### The Following Children are Screened for Suicide





#### Family Present During Pediatric Suicide Screening








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Healthcare Staff Performing Pediatric Mental Health Assessment




Is Training Provided to ED Staff on the Process for Pediatric Mental Health Assessment?





Access to Tele-Mental Health CLINICAL Services for Pediatric Patients




Access to Tele-Mental Health CONSULTATION Services for Pediatric Patients





Is there a Written Clinical Protocol Guideline for the Care of Children who Screen High Risk for Suicide?




Which Clinical ED Interventions for those who Screen High Risk for Suicide are Supported by the Following?


