Consider the following lists as models for building your local PRQC team – the lists are not exhaustive nor required.

Your Core Multidisciplinary Team	
<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ● Designated Team Leader ● Essential Stakeholder Representing the ED Care Team (i.e. A Physician, Advanced Practice Provider, Charge Nurse, Nurse) ● ED Leadership (Physician & Nursing) * ● Executive Sponsor ** 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ● Expanded group of representatives from ED Care team and other specialties (Pharmacy/ Social work/ licensed mental health professionals) ● Quality improvement specialist (quality/patient safety; risk management) ● Nurse Educator (ED and or Hospital) ● Data Support and/or EMR specialist

These individuals should be familiar with your hospital’s medical record, generation of electronic reports, data abstraction, and data entry. This role may be fulfilled by the site PRQC team lead.

*Not required to attend all meetings, but should be involved in decision making and final implementation

** Unlikely to attend all meetings, but should be kept apprised of team progress
