- Name and contact information of all team members who will be entering data and viewing performance reports
- Name and contact information of Participant Organization Agreement (POA) signatory

# Get your site excited about this opportunity!

- Share that you are joining a pediatric readiness quality improvement collaborative. This collaborative is focused on improving outcomes for children in your ED.
- The goal of NPRQI is to make implementation of pediatric quality improvement efforts as easy as possible. Participants will be able to compare themselves to similar ED structures and volumes.
- NPRQI is a quality improvement platform strictly developed for the purposes of capturing data elements during a patient encounter, evaluating performance on key measures, and aggregating data which will facilitate improvement efforts.

## **Participant Organization Agreement**

- Identify authorized personnel to sign the Participant Organization Agreement (POA). Examples of authorized signatories include: CEO, CFO, QI Director, ED Director, PECC
- Provide name, email, and phone number of authorizing signatory at your site.
- Download POA and follow instructions on the coversheet. POA outlines the purpose, benefits, security, and oversight that will be provided to all participant organizations.
- It will be helpful to obtain a survey link and return code during this part of registration to easily return to the registration portal to upload the signed POA.
- Upload completed and signed POA to registration portal.

## **Next Steps**

- Once the POA is fully executed (~approximately 2 weeks), a copy will be emailed to the organization's point of contact.
- All registered users for the data platform will receive an email invite from Clario tap.support@bioclinica.com with secure NPRQI login credentials.
- To prevent this email from being blocked by your organization's firewall, let your IT department know to "whitelist" the Clario email address.
