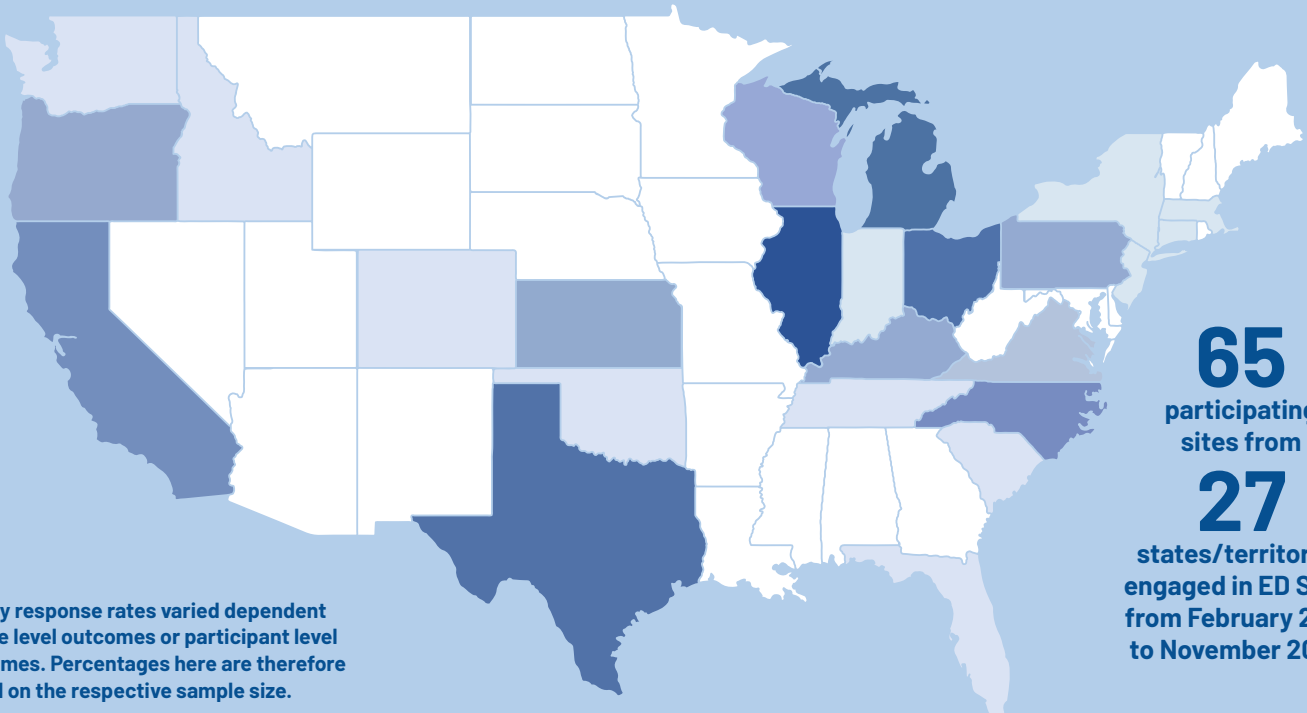


The ED Screening and Treatment Options for Pediatric (ED STOP) Suicide Quality Improvement (QI) Collaborative IMPACT REPORT*

Several ED sites selected to focus on more than one clinical area of focus to implement a QI project around.

SMART Aim Progress

52%

of ED sites achieved their SMART aim

66%

of ED sites plan to continue working on their SMART aim

Change Strategies

71%

of ED sites identified a change strategy around one of the four clinical areas of focus

66%

of ED sites implemented or plan to implement their change strategy

Overall Impact

88%

of participants stated that involvement in ED STOP led to positive change in their ED

80%

of participants have improved confidence in their ability to assist pediatric patients presenting with suicidal ideation
