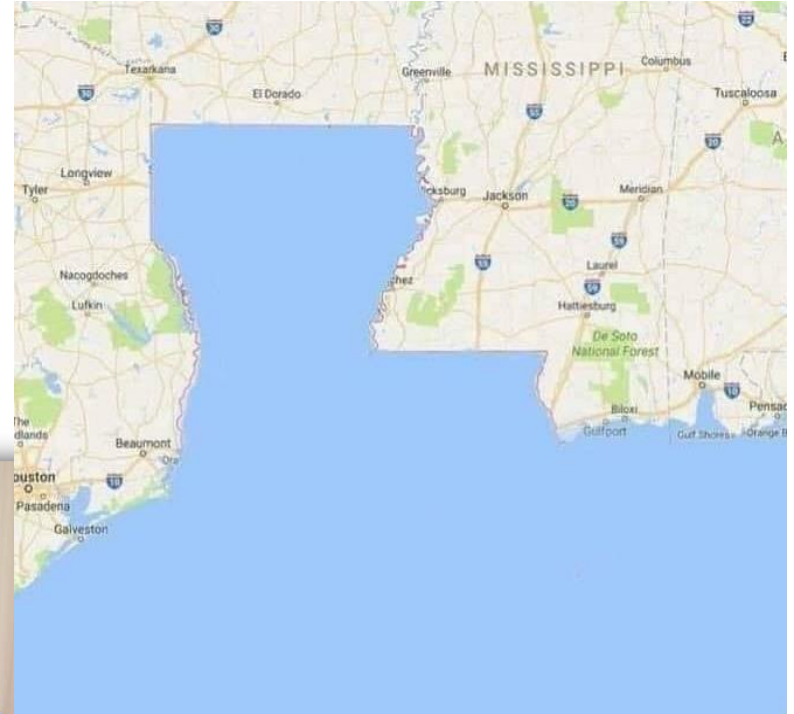

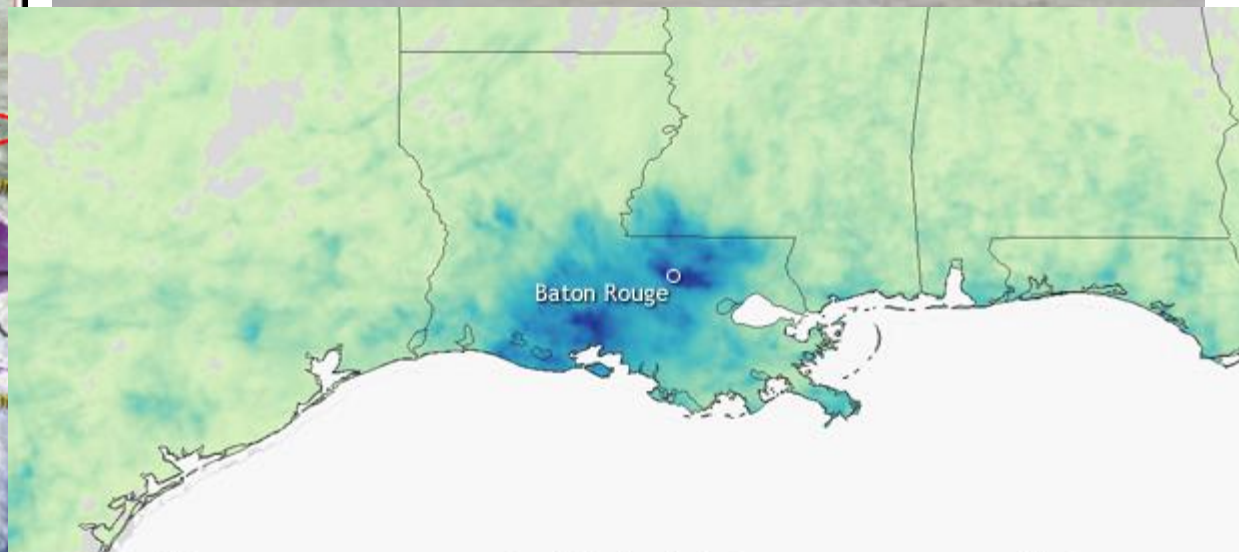

What is an Emergency?

To Providers	To Families
Natural Disasters	All of those plus:
Earthquake, fire, flood, mudslide, blizzard, hurricane, tornado	Unexpected Medical Event
Terrorism	Running out of meds/ supplies
Domestic, active shooter, national	Loss of electricity
Biological Events	No transportation
Pandemic viruses, etc.	Funding Source Interruptions
Evacuations or sheltering in place	Caregiver Separations



Whose Job is it Anyway?

Ways to help families understand the concept of emergency preparedness

- Identify likely threats
- Assess specific needs
- Evaluate capacity to respond

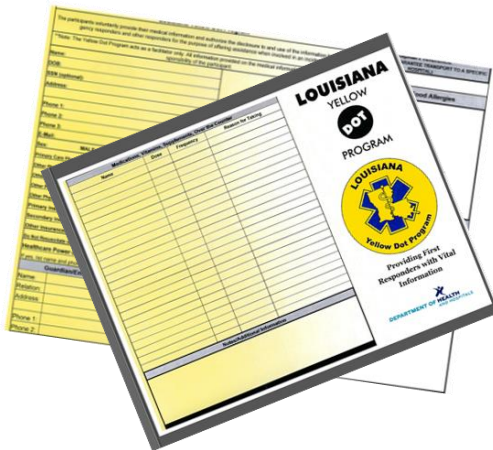


Ways to help families take ownership personal emergency preparedness

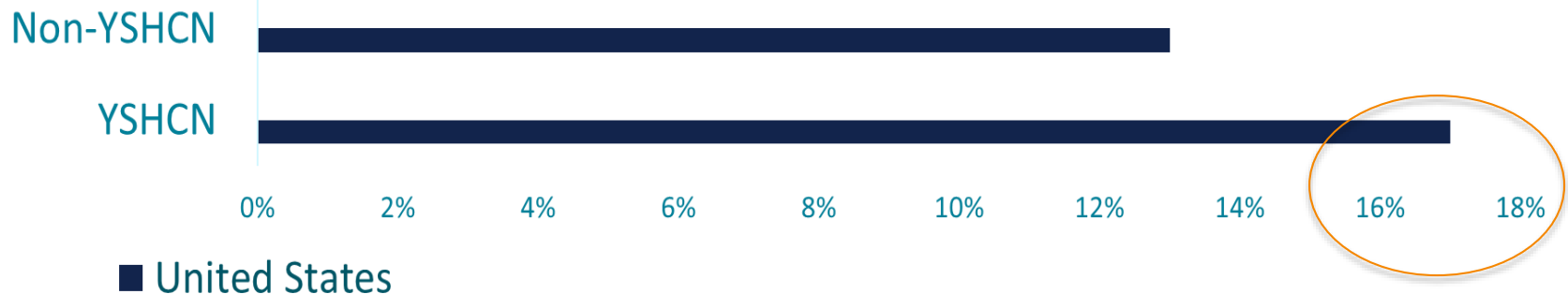
Preparedness = Peace of Mind!
